



2010 DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

Since 1991, the Foundation has awarded more than \$2.9 million through its scholarship programs. Launched for the first time in 2008, the Diversity Scholarship seeks to support newly admitted law students from groups historically underrepresented in the legal profession who have committed to attend a California law school. Candidates apply for the Scholarship at the beginning of the summer prior to commencing their law school studies. The Scholarship helps pay the costs of obtaining a law school education, including tuition, fees, books, and related education expenses. Awards of up to \$7,500 recognize incoming first-year law students with financial need who demonstrate a desire to make a positive impact as a community leader.

The top awards of \$7,500 may be made in the name of a Diversity Scholarship Fund donor. All 2010 Diversity Scholarships will be awarded in person at a reception to be held on Thursday, September 30, 2010, in Los Angeles.

CRITERIA, INSTRUCTIONS & CONDITIONS

The Diversity Scholarship is awarded in the fall of 2010 for the 2010-2011 academic year. The 2010 Application Deadline is **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 16, 2010**.

CRITERIA

1. Candidate must be:
 - Accepted and have committed to enroll in a California law school at the time of submitting an Application, and
 - Starting his or her first year at a California law school in the 2010-2011 academic year.
2. Candidate must self-identify as being from a racial or ethnic group that historically has been underrepresented in the legal profession.
3. Candidate must demonstrate financial need.
4. Candidate must be committed to making an impact in the community through leadership (there is no requirement that Candidate intend to pursue a career as a public interest attorney).
5. Candidate must submit two current **signed** letters of recommendation (letters may be copies of letters submitted with Candidate's law school applications). If possible, at least one letter should address Candidate's leadership qualities and/or community involvement.
6. Candidates are **not** nominated by their law school and should send application materials directly to the Foundation by the Application Deadline.
7. Candidates from online law schools must be California residents.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. All portions of the Application must be **received** by the Foundation by **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 16, 2010** (the "Application Deadline"). Attachments, letters of recommendation, and law school documents may be submitted separately, though **Candidates are strongly encouraged to submit one packet with all application materials**. Applications not received in full by the Foundation by the Application Deadline will not be considered.

Fax is the least optimal way to submit the application, though it is permitted. If faxing, please make sure that all pieces of the application are easily readable and sent together.
3. Applications postmarked by the Application Deadline but not received in full by the Application Deadline will not be accepted.
4. All documents submitted in association with Candidate's Application for the Diversity Scholarship should include the name of Candidate on each page, including law school documents and letters of recommendation.
5. Applications submitted via email should be sent as a single PDF document.
6. See the Application Checklist for a complete list of documentation that must be submitted.

CONDITIONS

1. Diversity Scholarship Recipients must:
 - Attend a reception in their honor, which is currently scheduled for Thursday, September 30, 2010, at 5:00 pm, in Los Angeles. The Foundation will provide stipends to help cover the travel costs of attending this event for Recipients who do not attend law school in the Los Angeles area. *Failure to attend may result in forfeiture of Recipient's Diversity Scholarship, without notice.*
 - Provide the Foundation, in a timely fashion, contact information for every date between the Application Deadline and the date of the Scholarship Reception. *Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of Recipient's Diversity Scholarship, without notice.*
 - Report back to the Foundation on the progress of their legal education at the end of their first year of law school.
2. Diversity Scholarship Recipients will be requested to provide a recent digital photograph of themselves upon receiving notification of their award. *Please do not send photos with Application.*
3. The Foundation reserves the right to use information from Applications and letters of recommendation as part of its publicity of Diversity Scholarship Recipients.
4. Diversity Scholarship Award Recipients receiving named scholarships may be asked to contact donors supporting their scholarships and invited to attend firm events.

Provide the Following Additional Documents:

- ✓ **Evidence of Acceptance to Law School** – Provide a copy of the acceptance letter from the law school where Candidate is committed to enroll in fall 2010.
- ✓ **Evidence of Commitment to Enroll in Law School** – Provide a copy of documentation from the law school evidencing Candidate's commitment to enroll in fall 2010. (e.g. receipt from payment of deposit, email from school acknowledging payment, etc.)
- ✓ **Resume** – Submit a resume documenting education and significant extracurricular activities since high school.
- ✓ **Personal Statement** – One-page statement of up to 500 words, describing Candidate's commitment to serving the community, and, if applicable, any significant obstacles or hurdles overcome to attend law school. Include a word count at the end of the statement. Applications with statements in excess of 500 words will **not** be considered.
- ✓ **Letters of Recommendation** – Two current **signed** letters of recommendation (letters may be copies of letters submitted with Candidate's law school applications). Letters may be sent to the Foundation directly or provided along with Candidate's Diversity Scholarship Application. At least one letter should address Candidate's leadership qualities and/or community involvement.
- ✓ **Undergraduate Transcript** – Copy of Candidate's final undergraduate transcript (include 2.5 equivalency for those schools that do not use a 4.0 scale). If final transcript is not yet available, provide the most recent copy. This **can** be an unofficial transcript, but it must **clearly identify** the applicant and the school by name.
- ✓ **Evidence of Financial Need** – Copy of financial aid eligibility letter received from the law school where Candidate will enroll in fall 2010.
- ✓ **Optional Statement of Financial Circumstances** – Candidate may choose to submit an additional, optional statement of up to 50 words describing any financial circumstances that Candidate believes may be relevant in determining Candidate's financial need (for example, if Candidate worked to pay for most or all undergraduate costs), and describing if Candidate has any loans outstanding from undergraduate or other graduate institutions, to the extent this information is not provided in the Evidence of Financial Need.

Note: Candidate's name must appear on each page of every document submitted with your Application, including letters of recommendation.
